


## Switching Modes on SureStat Thermostats

## Switching Thermostat Modes (Heating & Cooling):

- 1. Remove the 4 screws holding the front of the thermostat to the rear section, and open it.
- 2. Unscrew the yellow or blue terminal (whichever one has a wire attached).
- 3. Remove the black rubber plug in the unused terminal.
- 4. Secure the terminal and wire from step 2 to the terminal you just removed the plug from.
- 5. Screw the front cover back onto the thermostat.
- 6. Test the thermostat operation to make sure it is setup for the mode you want (see below).

## **Checking the Thermostat Mode:**

- Turn dial to 110°F. (heating mode) device should come on. (cooling mode) device should be off.
- Turn dial to 30° F. (heating mode) device should cut off. (cooling mode) device should come on.
- As the dial passes current room temperature, you should hear a faint click from the thermostat.
